MOUNTAIN VIEW SENIORS' HOUSING UNVEILS PRELIMINARY SUNDRÉ PROJECT PRE-DESIGN CONCEPT

Mountain View Seniors' Housing (MVSH) will share its preliminary pre-design concept for a proposed Sundre Project on July 5, 2012 at a meeting of the Sundre Community Seniors Care and Housing Committee. The meeting will be held at 1:00 pm at the Sundre Town Council Chambers.

The Sundre Community Seniors Care and Housing Committee initially requested MVSH to consider a project to help alleviate a proven existing demand and need for Seniors Care and Housing in Sundre and surrounding area. The MVSH Board unanimously supported the development of a pre-design concept based on their due diligence and proven demand.

Following feedback from this Community meeting, this Sundre pre-design concept will be finalized by MVSH and prepared for application to the Provincial Government, seeking capital project grant funding in early fall. If MVSH is successful in obtaining sufficient capital grant funding and approval from the Provincial Government, the Sundre Project will move to the planning stage for final approval by the MVSH Board and would take 3-4 years to complete.
