Chinook Winds Lodge (CWL) Evacuation Update

Dear CWL Residents and Families of Residents

We are writing today to communicate the date for Residents to move back into CWL after the remediation and equipment installations are complete.

The date for Residents to begin their move back into CWL will be September 26, 2017 starting at 9:00 AM. Since our last update and meeting on June 23, 2017 significant progress has been accomplished by all parties to this remediation for the flood which caused the evacuation.

The Province, MVSH, our insurers, our staff and our vendors supplying equipment and services have all been working hard. We are committed to continue to work hard to meet the recovery plan which will enable our inspectors to approved occupancy on September 26, 2017.

To review, the work done so far includes fixing the water meter and all water line related issues, the rebuilding of the damaged drywall and electrical work is under way, the mechanical equipment required has been ordered for supply and for engineered construction as required and the nurse call and telephone equipment has been ordered for supply and installation.

In addition to these evacuation related activities, the Province and MVSH are working to have the outstanding sprinkler, air conditioner and installation of the recently approved power back up generator ready for when CWL opens again. To be clear, none of these projects have any effect on the opening date, as we are simply trying hard to have all projects at CWL completed for the move in date.

We thank residents and families for their patience as we know this time during the evacuation has been stressful and inconvenient.



We now have a solid plan and timeline to bring the evacuation and all facility issues to a satisfactory conclusion. If there are any questions, please refer to the attached FAQs for the MVSH contact listed for each answer, or contact us directly so we can provide any information or support.
